

Live, Learn, & Play in Northern NH

Program Expectations

Participants who apply to the Live, Learn, & Play in Northern NH Program must:

- ◆ Complete a Live, Learn, & Play in Northern NH Program application and submit to:

- ◆ If possible, please submit your application at least **one month** prior to your rotation start date.
- ◆ If offered, accept a spot in the Live, Learn, & Play in Northern NH program.

Participants accepted to the Live, Learn, & Play in Northern NH Program will:

- ◆ Call the program coordinator two weeks prior of the start of the rotation to confirm the dates and details of the rotation.
- ◆ Work with the program coordinator to arrange housing, if needed.
- ◆ Receive educational support up to \$1,000 to offset living expenses.
- ◆ Have a clinical preceptor.
- ◆ Work with the program coordinator to identify and design a community project.
- ◆ Complete a community service project during the rotation (please see community project guidelines).
- ◆ Submit a community service project reflection following the rotation.
- ◆ Complete a pre and post-rotation evaluation.
- ◆ Participate in program activities when schedule permits.

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Program Expectations

The North Country Health Consortium will:

- ◆ Provide the student with application status information.
- ◆ Take into consideration a student's site preference when designing a rotation.
- ◆ Work with the student's rotation advisor to arrange placement.
- ◆ Work with student to find available housing, if needed.
- ◆ Send a confirmation email to the student finalizing the details of the rotation and the pre-rotation evaluation.
- ◆ Send a confirmation email to the clinical site finalizing the details of the rotation.
- ◆ Provide the student with an educational support payment up to \$1,000.
- ◆ Follow-up with the student during the first week of his or her rotation to assure that all details have been finalized and a community project has been designed.
- ◆ Monitor the student's community project and keep a copy of the community service reflection.
- ◆ Coordinate activities for students throughout their rotation.
